IFSHA CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Adopted 7/11/2019

All members of the International Friesian Show Horse Association (IFSHA) believe our conduct matters for both the well-being of the association and its members. We as an association are formed to promote the breeding, care, and showing of Friesian horses.

As members, our conduct transcends all areas of our goals, and includes how we deal with each other internally, and how we deal with the industry as a whole.

Our Code of Conduct sets forth our basic ethical principles and core values that are applicable to all of us. It helps guide us on how we conduct our association and activities.

All members are responsible for understanding and complying with the IFSHA Code of Conduct. All members are expected to:

- Promote ethical behavior at all shows and activities of IFSHA.
- Respect all other members and refrain from disparaging remarks about members or acts that are unethical.
- Promote the humane care of horses.
- Maintain a safe environment for all horses, their riders, owners, and participants.
- Promote IFSHA in a favorable light to the public and the industry.
- Comply with this Code of Conduct, knowing that failure to do so may result in punitive action by IFSHA, up to and including termination of membership.

2026 IFSHA GRAND NATIONAL SHOW ENTRY PROCEDURES

Information to include in Entry Package:

1. Completed USEF National Show Entries are due: **Postmarked by SEPT. 26, 2026.**
2. Copies of all membership cards for Owner/Horse/Exhibitors (IFSHA & USEF).
3. Horse registration papers (both sides).
4. Horse health records: Required EIA (negative Coggins), vaccination records as required by USEF, must be included in the entry package. Interstate Health Certificate for horses traveling from outside the state of Virginia. This is a required document, and a copy must be turned in to the Show Office upon arrival at Virginia Horse Center.
5. Payment in full must accompany each completed entry. Credit card payment is available with a 3.5% service charge of the total bill. A separate signed check is to be used for closeout of the account at the close of the show.
6. Proof of USEF SafeSport Certification.

Signatures:

- The entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the proper signatures, membership numbers, and horse information. Each entry must have original signatures of the: Rider/Handler/Driver/the Owner/Agent and the Trainer.
- A **TRAINER**, as listed on the entry form, is defined as any adult (18 & older) who has responsibility for the care, custody, or performance of the horse while the horse is on the competition grounds. This adult must sign in the “Trainer’s Section.” If the rider is considered the trainer, the rider must sign as the trainer.
- A parent or guardian signing on behalf of a Junior Exhibitor must be a USEF member. The owner may also sign as the trainer if he or she is present on the show grounds during the event. If not, the entry must be signed by the responsible adult (18 & older) that is responsible for the horse during the event.
- Depending on the circumstances, there also may be a requirement for the signature of the “Coach.” A **COACH**, as listed on the form, is defined as an adult (18 & older) who gets paid for instructing, teaching, schooling, or advising a rider with their horse on the competition grounds. This adult must sign the entry form as coach. If there is no coach, the space for coach signature may be left blank.

2026 IFSHA GRAND NATIONAL SHOW EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

<i>No qualification necessary for the 2026 IFSHA Grand National Show.</i>

USEF Amateur Status:

Proof must accompany Amateur Entries. USEF no longer allows Amateurs to show with a "Show Pass." To be eligible to show in an Amateur Class, a copy of the competitor's USEF Amateur Member Card, along with proof of SafeSport Certification must be provided to the Show Office.

Junior Exhibitors/Vintage Riders:

Riders in these classes must indicate their date of birth on the entry form.

Ridden Dressage (English):

Dressage entries are limited to 60 rides. Rides will be assigned as entries are received. A wait list will be maintained for any entries above the 60 rides. Dressage classes may not run in listed order. Official times will be posted in the Horse Show Office by noon the day proceeding the first day of competition.

EXHIBITOR must specify on the entry form the division to be entered: Open, Amateur, or Junior Exhibitor. Entries must be received by **September 26th, 2026.**

Horse Health Requirements:

ALL ENTRIES without a current negative Coggins (valid through the show dates) and required USEF vaccinations WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO STABLE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE IFSHA GRAND NATIONAL SHOW. This rule is for ALL horses stabling with IFSHA.

USEF Vaccination Rule:

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses **7 months of age**, entering the show grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino Pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the show stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon the request of the Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturer's or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered under the direction of a veterinarian.
1.A In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian that the horse in question has received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines, and the date of administration.
1.B In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request of Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase, which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse. Vaccine name, serial number, expiration date of the vaccine, and the date the vaccine was administered must be supplied to the Competition Management.

1.C In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by the Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead of the veterinarian, stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns, and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the 7 days prior to entering the show grounds. The log of temperatures is to be provided to the Competition Management, Show Steward, and/or Technical Delegate.

Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the USEF Veterinary Committee. BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15, 1/16/16, Effective 4/1/16.

The 2026 IFSHA Grand National Show is a USEF Licensed Competition. Every Friesian and Part Bred Friesian class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation Rule Book; and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The rules of the Federation take precedence over the rules of any other association, with the exception of information printed within the National Show Prize List. Exhibitors are encouraged to refer to the Federation Rule Book, which is online at www.usef.org. A Federation Steward approved by Show Management shall be present to administer these rules at the show.

IFSHA/USEF/SAFESPORT:

Owners and their horses are to be members of both IFSHA and USEF to participate in the IFSHA Grand National Show; and must be current with the USEF SafeSport initiative. Non-owner exhibitors (Jr. Exhibitors/Open) may purchase an IFSHA Show Pass and USEF Show Pass to compete.

Adult Amateur Exhibitors must be members of USEF and be current with the USEF SafeSport initiative. IFSHA Memberships (Owner and Horse) may be completed with the IFSHA Office at least 5 days prior to the start of the show. A copy of horse's registration papers must be submitted.

Minor Exhibitors:

Parents/Guardians of minor exhibitors shall not hold the United States Equestrian Federation, the International Friesian Show Horse Association, IFSHA Show Officials and Show Staff, or the Virginia Horse Center Foundation responsible for injury to such a minor. No child's entry will be accepted unless the minor's entry is **SIGNED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN**. The signatures of Instructors, Agents, or other unrelated persons **will not be accepted**.

USEF Drug Fee:

For every horse in USEF classes, a \$23.00 USEF Drugs and Medications Fee will be collected. This fee does not apply to horses entered only in Opportunity Classes.

USEF Membership/ Non-Member/ Proof of Membership/ Show Pass: Effective 12/1/2022

Per GR 206.9, a fee of \$45.00 will be collected from participants who are not USEF members that will be competing in USEF classes. Show passes **do not** enable an exhibitor to compete in an amateur class. All amateur exhibitors must be members of USEF and be current with SafeSport Certification. All participants (rider, owner, trainer, agent, lease, or coach) must provide to the Show Secretary a current USEF membership number. In the event a rider or owner does not have his or her membership number, he or she must pay a \$45.00 USEF Show Pass Fee. Show Pass purchase can **ONLY BE MADE ONLINE THROUGH USEF**. Trainers and coaches, including parents signing an entry blank or acting as a trainer or coach, must be an Active USEF member and are NOT eligible to participate under a Show Pass.

HORSE SHOW EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Horse Show Executive Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, and their decision is to be final. The Horse Show Executive Committee will consist of the Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary, and the IFSHA Executive Director.

2026 IFSHA GRAND NATIONAL SHOW EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Entry Forms:

No entry form will be accepted and considered a **PRE-ENTRY** unless all items listed above, including all signatures required and full payment of fees **are received together with the entry forms**. Use only the entry forms provided by IFSHA (you may photocopy if more than one is needed). **Use a separate form for each horse.** All entries are due by **September 11th, 2026**.

- **Individual horses are limited to 3 Dressage tests per day.**
- **A Friesian or Part bred Friesian horse may not be shown in more than 5 performance classes (which would include equitation, liberty, and opportunity classes) per day.** There is no limit to the number of classes a horse may be shown for In Hand/Halter/Showmanship classes.
- Part bred horses must be at least 50% Friesian.

Concurrent Classes:

Purebred Friesians and Part bred Friesians shown concurrently in the same class will be judged and awarded separately, just as if the class was conducted separately. Exception: In Equitation and Showmanship, Purebred and Part bred horses may be judged in the same class.

Class Adds:

Classes may be added to the entry after the closing date with no penalty. The class is to be added by using the official form provided by the Show Office. Class additions must be done prior to the class session and according to the following schedule:

- Morning additions will need to be added by **7:00 PM** the evening before.
- Afternoon additions will need to be added by **10:00 AM** the day of the class.
- Evening additions will need to be added by **2:00 PM** the day of the class.
- All class add forms will need to be signed by an adult member of the exhibitor's team.

Class Holds

There will be a two-minute gate time between each class. When absolutely necessary, a limited, longer hold may be requested; and may be permitted at the discretion of the Show Manager.

Class Scratches:

Class scratch refunds will no longer be allowed without a note from the vet. You are welcome to exchange a class for the same horse and rider. Please do this at the time of the scratch.

Failure to Appear:

“No Shows” are disruptive to the show; and exhibitors will be charged a **\$25.00 penalty** for each class in which a competitor who entered a class fails to appear for the class without having informed the office of a class scratch. A second “No Show” by the same entrant will be charged an additional \$25.00 penalty and the entry may be considered a scratch for the rest of the day. **No refunds will be granted; and all such penalties will be assessed to the entrant's open check or credit card as pre-authorized, prior to leaving the show grounds at the end of the competition.** Special circumstances will, of course, be given consideration by the Show Manager.

Substitutions:

Once entered, owners may substitute and entrant with submission of a veterinary certificate verifying the horse's illness/injury and inability to compete; or proof that the entrant has been sold or is deceased. In the event of a substitution, the Show Secretary must be notified at least **48 hours before the show date** and a new entry form is to be completed.

Payment:

Unless fees are paid at time of show registration/entry, stalls will not be reserved, shavings will not be ordered, and back/bridle tag will not be issued.

Each competitor is required to leave a signed open check or credit card authorization with the Show Secretary prior to receiving back/bridle tags. Management may require cash, certified check, cashier's check or money order from any entry who has had a past payment NSF with IFSHA.

Office Fee/Show Office Hours:

Each horse entered in the IFSHA Grand National Show will be charged a fee of \$40.00 per horse. The Show Office will be open on Wednesday, October 7th, 2026, by noon. Liz Holmes will be the Show Secretary for 2026. On competition days, the Show Office will open 1 hour prior to the beginning of the first session and will close 30 minutes after the last class of the day. Show Management will be on the grounds with the same schedule.

Final Bill:

Please close out your bill and pick up your final billing statement in the Show Office by close of the show on **Sunday, October 11, 2026**. Check over your final billing statement carefully before leaving the show. It will be assumed to be accurate once you have signed off. Your account will be closed out for you if you do not come to the Show Office to do so.

Refunds:

Entries will only be refunded (minus a \$25.00 handling fee) if a vet certificate verifying the horse's illness or injury and inability to compete is received **within 5 days of the event**. **No refunds will be issued for stabling fees or pre-ordered shavings**. Refunds in the event of severe weather or state/local emergency will be granted at the discretion of IFSHA and show management.

Returned Checks:

Returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$50.00, or 10% of the balance due (whichever is greater), and may be subject to the provisions of the USEF for non-payment. Unpaid balances will be charged 1.5% per month and a fee of \$25.00 per month. No payment will be processed a second time after it has been returned by the bank as NSF; and monies still due to the show or IFSHA shall be paid by certified check, cashier's check, or money order.

HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT

Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, cancel any entries, disqualify any rides or exhibitors, prohibit entries, and cancel awards prizes without claims for damages; as well as to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes and to change rings, judges, or other officials. The class schedule in this book is tentative. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the class schedule and class order. If entries warrant, performance may begin earlier or later than published. If entries

warrant, classes may be split or combined. Show Management reserves the right to change, reschedule, or cancel classes due to scheduling or weather conditions.

Daily Show Schedule:

The Show Office will provide a daily show schedule with updates. Please check with the Show Office each day for the current updates.

Class Calls:

Due to potential unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device or PA systems, **all paddock calls must be considered a courtesy.** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that their horse is at the entry gate when the class is ready to begin. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor any class be changed due to a PA malfunction. There may be up to a 6-minute break when classes are cancelled. The 2-minute gate will be adhered to. Breaks and lunches will be scheduled throughout the day.

Helmets:

All exhibitors 18 and younger are required to have a helmet on at all times when mounted. Helmet use is recommended for all riders regardless of age.

Drug Tests:

All horses are subject to random testing at any time during the show.

Hoof and Shoe Inspections:

Random inspection of toe length, hoof construction, hoof pads, and shoe gauge may be performed. See the USEF rules for specifications and rules. The USEF Show Steward will have the option to inspect at any time.

Stabling:

IFSHA and Show Management will make every effort to accommodate requests to be stabled next to or near other competitors while assigning specific stalls. However, IFSHA, Show Management, and the Barn Manager can make no specific guarantees as to the availability or feasibility of specific stall layouts.

Stalls: Stalls are 10' wide x 12' deep with 7'10" tall walls. Doors are 5' 7/8" wide.

Stalls with doors, where occupied with horses, feed, or tack will be available for \$175.00 per show week, Tuesday through Saturday. **Move-in day is Monday, October 5th, 2026, NO EARLIER than 03:00 pm. All horses must be out of the stalls by Monday, October 12th, at 12:00 PM.** Stalls are 10 x 12 with clay floors. Wash racks are indoors. The use of nails, Velcro, drilling, duct tape, and rubber cement is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED.** The exhibitor is responsible and will be billed for any repair necessary. All extension cords must have **GFCI Protected on them, and a 3-prong plug.** Cords may not be installed through doors. The premises will be checked for compliance.

Shavings:

Shavings may be purchased from the Virginia Horse Center; or exhibitors may bring their own shavings. **No outside vendor may deliver shavings to VHC.** At departure from the show, stalls must be in their original condition, with the exception of shavings and horse manure.

Main Arena Specifications, Virginia Horse Center:

Anderson Coliseum, Waldron Arena—150' X 300', clay base, natural sand mix. Moore Arena (outdoor covered warm-up arena)—96' X 220', sand/clay mix.

Sharps Containers:

Sharps containers are located throughout the stabling area; and must be used for the disposal of needles and medical sharps. Show Management may fine owners, exhibitors, trainers, or agents for improper disposal of needles or medical sharps.

No Smoking:

SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE BARNS, ARENAS, OR STAGING AREAS ON THE VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER GROUNDS. Anyone who is found smoking in the barns may be fined up to \$1000.00. Spectators will be asked to extinguish the smoking item or be asked to leave.

Show Attire:

No handler, exhibitor, rider, or driver shall be allowed to enter a class wearing clothing that displays logos or wording that would identify any farm/business/owner/breeder. Jeans or shorts are not acceptable attire for handlers/assistants/horse holders in halter or in-hand classes. Please see USEF rules for proper attire for each division. Horses are not allowed to use saddle pads that identify any farm/business/owner/breeder.

Dogs:

Dogs will be allowed on the competition grounds but **MUST** be on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times when not in a crate or kennel. Individuals must not lead a dog while mounted. **Dogs are not allowed in the arenas, in any of the rings, or at any entry point of the show arena. In the event that dogs become a problem on the concourse areas, the handler will be asked to remove the dog from the area.** Per USEF Rule, GR 1301.6, dog owners who fail to comply with these rules will be issued a Yellow Warning Card and will be subject to penalties under Chapters 6 and 7. **SERVICE DOGS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS RULE.**

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active, and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions and the Modified Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions, and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass Fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline, 2) exhibitions, 3) games and races, 4) classes for 4-H members, 5) walk trot (exception Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program), 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed reining competitions, 8) opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division, and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICAL STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule is solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management, is their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF SAFESPORT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Approved August 27, 2018

SafeSport Rule Part 3

1. Every USEF member and Federation Participant* shall abide by USEF's SafeSport Policy and the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code of Conduct.* As described by the USEF SafeSport Policy, Federation Participant is any USEF member or non-member who participates in, or attends a USEF-Licensed competition or sanctioned event.
2. In order to comply with S.534 the Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017, the USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Center's SafeSport Code of Conduct, every USEF adult member and USEF participant, with the exception of the victim, is required to report sexual misconduct within 24 hours to the appropriate authorities and to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
3. Beginning January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's SafeSport Training, as approved by the U.S. Center for SafeSport (the center). BOD 8/27/18

Renewing USEF members must complete SafeSport training before competing.

*****A copy of your SafeSport Certificate of Completion must be submitted with entry if you are 18 years & over, unless completion is printed on your USEF Membership Card.***

MAAPP

It is a recent requirement that all USEF licensed competition participants be notified that 1) They adhere to the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policies (MAAPP) and 2) How to report violations and abuse allegations.

For background, the federal law known as Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and SafeSport Authorization Act of 2017 authorizes the U.S. Center for SafeSport (the center) to develop training and policies to prevent abuse, including physical, emotional, and sexual abuse within the US Olympic and Paralympic movements. It also mandates that reasonable procedures are established for one-on-one interactions with minor athletes. To this end the Center has drafted MAAPP which apply to all national governing bodies for sport, including the USEF.

USEF Participants are bound by the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and MAAPP. This includes the SafeSport training requirement for adult members and participants who have regular contact with minor athletes. Any concerns that are non-sexual in nature, please use the USEF SafeSport Incident Reporting Form available on the USEF website.
